# Health, hygiene and other safety protocols before opening of schools

Prior to resumption of school activities, all work areas including libraries, laboratories, storage places, water tanks, washrooms/toilets and other areas of common use, furniture etc are deep cleaned and sanitized.



# Provisions made inside the school

- ❖ For ensuring social distancing and queue management inside the premises, specific markings are made on the floor/ ground near the common use areas like washroom, wash area, corridor etc. with a gap of 6 feet .
- ❖ Students are advised to keep left while moving in the campus



# Provisions made inside the school

- ❖ Posters and banners on preventive measures, safety, health and hygiene about COVID-19 are displayed prominently in the campus and classrooms.

## PREVENTION CORONAVIRUS



### WASH YOUR HANDS

Wash them often, with water and lots of soap. Wash at least 20 seconds.



### SNEEZING/ COUGHING ETIQUETTE

Cover your mouth when you cough or sneeze, with a tissue or the inside of your elbow



### EYES, NOSE, MOUTH

Hands touch many surfaces and can pick up viruses. Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth. The virus can enter your body and can make you sick.



### IF YOU'RE SICK

if you have a flu-like illness, inform the people around you. If your illness isn't mild, seek medical care.

## Coughing and sneezing etiquette



Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue.



Dispose of your tissue properly.



If there is no tissue, cough or sneeze into the bend of elbow – not your hand.



If you sneeze or cough into hand, wash your hands as soon as possible.

# Provisions made inside the school

- All used areas will be sanitized everyday with particular attention to frequently touched surfaces.
- Provision of liquid soap in toilets and hand sanitizers in other places/ facilities of common use is ensured.
- One isolation room is ready in case of emergency
- Assembly and sports will not be conducted
- Yoga and basic exercises will be conducted on need basis



# Provisions made inside the school

- Thermal screening and hand sanitization will be done for everyone while entering the school. If any student is detected with temperature more than 99<sup>0</sup>F she/he will be sent back to home with intimation to parents.
- A monitoring team comprising of one teacher, a parent member and a doctor will be formed and regular monitoring of hygiene and sanitization will be monitored by them.
- Doctor will be visiting frequently and random check up of students will be done.
- Recess break, entry and exit will be staggered for different classes.



# CLASS ROOM ARRANGEMENTS

- Inside classrooms, students will be made to sit at safe distances i.e. only one student will sit on a dual desk cum bench
- A particular seat/ space should be earmarked for each student with their name written
- Maximum 20 students would be allowed to sit in a class room and 13 students in a lab to ensure safe distancing among students

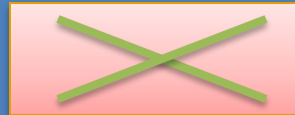

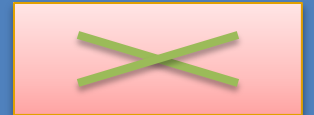
# CLASS ROOM ARRANGEMENTS

- All windows and doors will be kept open for proper ventilation
- Teachers will make adequate distance from the students and they will not go around the class
- Morning prayer will be done in the class room

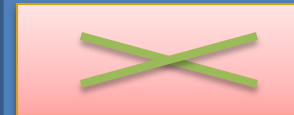

# GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

- Students should bring their own drinking water.
- Nutritious food should be brought from home only
- Food should not be shared with others
- Every student should bring a table placemat/napkin, which should be spread over the table while having breakfast.
- Students should wear their face mask and bring their own sanitizer. Students and staff should continue wearing face mask throughout their presence in the campus.



# GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

- Birthday celebrations will not be allowed and birthday students should not bring any eatable for their classmates/others.
- Physical distancing of 6 feet should be maintained everywhere throughout the school hours.



# GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

- Every child needs to learn and practice how to cough, sneeze into a tissue/ elbow and avoid touching face, eyes, mouth and nose.




Avoid the use of open hands or closed fist to cover your cough. It spreads germs through the air and makes it easy to transfer the germs to other surfaces through touching.



Cough or sneeze into the fold of your arm, trapping germs within the easily washable fabric of your clothes.



# GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

- Only one student at a time will be allowed for bio breaks.
  - Students should not share any textbooks, note books, stationery, lunch/snacks box, water bottles etc. with others
  - Spitting is strictly prohibited inside the campus.
  - Students should immediately inform if they develop any symptom
  - Please follow the instructions displayed or communicated by the teachers without any deviation

## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARENTS

- Students can attend school only and only with the **written consent** of parents. Sending students to school is the sole discretion of parents.
- Parents are requested to ensure that the mask of their wards are washed everyday. Please provide a spare mask in your ward's bag which can be used if the child loses or soils the mask.
- Don't send your ward to school if she/he is suffering from cold, cough, fever.
- For the time being school has not taken decision about transport. So parents are requested to make their own arrangements. When school transport begin, then a separate written consent is required from the parents to avail the school transport.



# GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARENTS

- School will take best possible prevention measures and care of the students. If still a child develops any symptom then she/he will be isolated immediately and the parents will be informed to take the child from school.
- God forbid, but if a child or any of the family members gets infected with COVID-19 then the school should be informed immediately and the child should stop coming to school. Only after complete recovery the child will be allowed to school on producing the COVID negative report to the school authority.
- Encourage your wards to follow the guidelines laid down by school and communicated from time to time.



# Academic activities

- Syllabus is completed in mid December through online mode of teaching
- Chapter wise revision will be done for all subjects and the revision schedule will be shared by the teachers shortly
- Chapter wise copy checking for the students will be done
- Practical classes will be held everyday for class XII and weekly for class X
- Doubt clearing and sample paper discussion will take place after completion of chapter wise revision
- Academic activity monitoring team comprising of the class teachers will closely monitor the students progress.
